ARTISAN PILSNER

This is an old crisp classic, but bit fuller, flavorful and enjoyable than mass-market versions.

Appearance: light golden clear color, fine white head with medium retention.

Aroma: pleasant herbal and spicy aroma, usually attributed to noble hop varieties, slight malty notes.

Tasting notes: crisp refreshing apparent hoppy bitterness intertwines with malty notes to create a balanced and rounded impression.

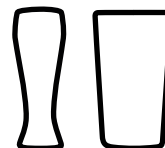
Aftertaste: lingering soft pleasant bitterness, without harshness.

Malts: Bohemian Pilsner

Hops: Magnum, Saaz

SAMURAI'S DAUGHTER

Very light and refreshing rice ale with ginger. Great balance without too much of ginger spiciness. Amazing thirst quencher. Perfect for Asian and Japanese food-pairings.

Appearance: light straw colour, fine white head.

Aroma: fresh crisp maltiness, hints of ginger.

Tasting notes: very refreshing, light, comparatively neutral, effervescent, light touch of ginger, very drinkable.

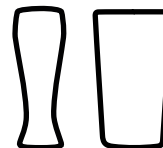
Aftertaste: pleasant freshness with ginger notes.

BLANCHE DE BLANCHE

Obvious choice for a Belgian-style wheat beer lovers, refreshing, summery, bright and crisp, with coriander seeds and orange peel.

Appearance: hazy straw, white fine head with medium retention.

Aroma: malt, wheat, citrusy tartness, spicy, coriander notes.

Tasting notes: wheat and grain notes, citrusy and spicy undertones, slight yeasty bitterness, hops are moderate.

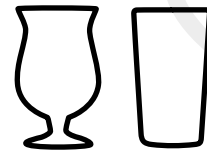
Aftertaste: pleasant wheat notes, pronounced orange peel, coriander in the finish.

Malts: Pilsner, Wheat Malt, Wheat, Oats

VARVAR - DRY - STOUT



DRY STOUT

Full of roasted flavor, dominated by coffee notes and notes of extra-dark chocolate. Preferred by drinkers of dry dark beer devoid of malty sweetness, Guinness lovers. The most classical recipe in our collection.

Appearance: almost black in color, big tan head with long retention.

Aroma: hops are almost non-existent, moderate coffee of toasty aroma, delicate hints of chocolate and caramel.

Tasting notes: toasty notes of coffee and specialty malts, bread, fruity notes, almost no hop bitterness.

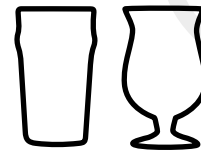
Aftertaste: dry coffee-like finish, with accentuated bitterness and acidity.

Malts: Pale Ale Malt, Chocolate Malt, Carafa 3, Roasted Barley

Hops: Magnum, Chinook

CAPTAIN SALT

One of the most unusual and interesting styles we've ever brewed. It's a wheat beer with salt and coriander. Your first thoughts will be of sea.

Appearance: light golden, fine white head.

Aroma: tart, fresh, wheat, coriander hints.

Tasting notes: starts with pronounced tartness, continuing into salty and spicy notes of coriander, and back to pleasant tartness again.

Aftertaste: lingering tartness with hints of salt.

Malts: Pilsner, Wheat Malt

Hops: Hallertauer Melon

MILK STOUT

Full-bodied, dark beer of sweet and roasty taste. Preferred by aficionados of dark beer, coffee-lovers and taste explorers.

Appearance: opaque dark brown to black in color. Tan head with medium retention.

Aroma: roasted, nutty notes, gentle bitterness of roasted malts, hop aroma low to none.

Tasting notes: dark roasted grain and malt dominate the taste, slight acidity, distinct sweetness of lactose. Bitterness of roasted malts and coffee.

Aftertaste: sweetness is fading, bitterness becomes more pronounced and herbal.

Awards: Bronze International Beer Challenge 2017, Country Winner WBA 2017.

Malts: Pale Ale, Rye Malt, Carafo 3, Chocolate Malt, Special W, Roasted Barley

Hops: Magnum, Centennial

GOLDEN ALE

Full-bodied, sweet and intense ale with big aroma. Preferred by drinkers of beer more to the sweet than bitter side. ABV is well hidden.

Appearance: clear golden, fine white head with good retention.

Aroma: ripe melon, strawberries, meadow flowers.

Tasting notes: slight berry tartness, hints of honey and toffee, ripe fruits. Bitterness is medium, of grassy kind. Notes of peppery phenols.

Aftertaste: fading sweetness balanced by low tartness and dry hoppiness.

Awards: Bronze International Beer Challenge 2017.

Malts: Bohemian Pilsner, CaraPils, Wheat Malt

Hops: Magnum, Hallertau Melon, Amarillo

HOPPY LAGER

Light, drinkable, refreshing and aromatic lager. Best suitable for engaging traditional beer drinkers into craft beer world.

Appearance: clear light-straw color, fine white head with medium retention.

Aroma: fresh citrusy aroma, floral and herbal notes, low sweet maltiness.

Tasting notes: medium maltiness balanced by citrusy bitterness with undertones of tropical fruits, herbal notes. Medium but accentuated bitterness with hints of grass and wood.

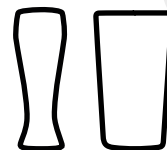
Aftertaste: bitterness is lowered by malty and fruity sweetness with hints of citrusy tartness.

Malts: Bohemian Pilsner, CaraPils

Hops: Magnum, Mosaic

CARIBBEAN DREAM

Our collaboration with home-brewer contest winner. Adventurous coconut experiment where we have added coconut on various brewing stages. Liquid “Bounty” bar they call it.

Appearance: black, opaque, fine creamy head.

Aroma: dark roasted malts, chocolate, coffee, coconut notes.

Tasting notes: deep malty and chocolaty taste, roastiness is evident but not overwhelming, pronounced coconut notes, hop bitterness is low.

Aftertaste: fading chocolatey notes, hints of sweetness.

Malts: Pilsner, Chocolate Malt, Cara-Pils, Caramunich II, Carafa Special II, CaraAroma

Hops: Columbus, Saaz

The style is enjoyed by hop-heads, who adore intense bitterness of hops. This beer features Citra in the boil and cold hopping as well. This hop variety will drag you into the whirlpool of citrus and ripe tropical fruits.

Appearance: clear amber, fine white head with medium retention.

Aroma: intense citrusy hops aroma, fresh and vibrant, notes of strawberries, melon, peach.

Tasting notes: pronounced citrusy bitterness, grapefruit and lime fading into sweetness of ripe fruits, undertones of peaches, hints of melon, lychee.

Aftertaste: long-lasting grapefruit bitterness, tropical fruits on the end.

Malts: Pale Ale Malt, CaraPils, Viena Malt

Hops: Citra

Iconic style of the US craft beer revolution, one of the first and most popular. Packed with high-alfa new-world hop varieties, bitter and aromatic. Preferred by beer-drinkers involved in craft-beer scene and bitter styles lovers.

Appearance: clear deep golden to light amber color, fine white head with medium retention.

Aroma: floral, citrusy and piney notes prevail.

Tasting notes: mix of citrusy grapefruit pulp bitterness, sweetness of tropical fruits, malty sweetness is low.

Aftertaste: grapefruit bitterness in finish, hints of fruity sweetness.

Malts: Pale Ale Malt, Biscuit Malt, CaraRed

Hops: Columbus, Willamette, Citra, Mosaic, Cascade

BLACK IPA

One of our most bitter beers. The same vivid IPA, but this time it's black!

Appearance: deep dark-brown color, fine tan head with good retention.

Aroma: intense pine and wood in aroma, undertones of tropical fruits, slight hints of roasted coffee.

Tasting notes: light citrus and berry tartness, piny and resinous notes, tropical fruits. Hoppy bitterness is high, moderate coffee roastiness.

Aftertaste: dry finish, piny bitterness with citrusy notes layered with roasted coffee notes.

Malts: Pale Ale Malt, Caraaroma, Carafa Special II, Chocolate Malt

Hops: Chinook, Simcoe, Cascade, Centennial

EQUINOX DIPA

Best choice for new taste explorers and hop bitterness lovers. It will be bitter.

Appearance: golden to amber, clear, fine white head with medium retention.

Aroma: vivid citrusy aroma with undertones of fruits, hints of peppery notes.

Tasting notes: well-rounded bitterness, citrusy upfront, fruity and peppery background, malty and fruity sweetness in the end.

Aftertaste: hoppy bitterness fading into tropical fruitiness and lasts for a long time.

Awards: Country Winner WBA 2017.

Malts: Pilsner, Vienna

Hops: Columbus, Equinox, Endeavour

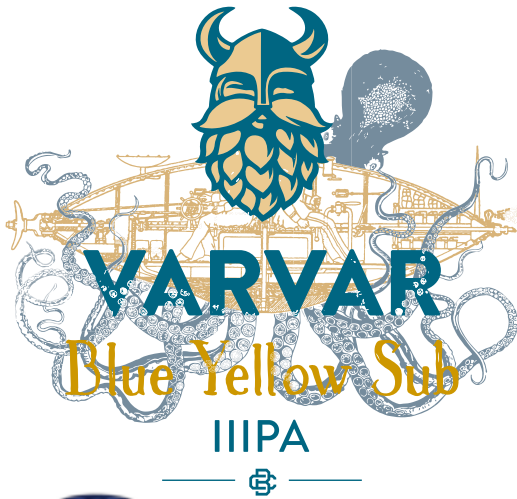

BLUEYELLOW SUB DOUBLE IPA

Imperial/Double IPA is considered twice or even thrice as hopped and strong as IPA. This is a must-try for those who aim for taste and experience variety.

Appearance: clear bright golden in color, fine white head with medium retention.

Aroma: pine and spruce in aroma, distinct notes of tropical fruits, peach, plum.

Tasting notes: medium maltiness, balanced by fruity tartness, medium hoppiness, plum notes.

Aftertaste: long dry and bitter finish, wood and spruce, sweet fruity undertones, warming alcohol notes.

Malts: Premium Pilsner, CaraPils

Hops: Columbus, Yellow Sub

IMPERIAL STOUT

Imperial stout is intense, complex, multi-layered beer fully deserving its crowned status. Beer for leisurely and thoughtful enjoyment. Must have for beer-geeks, strong drinks aficionados and drinkers in search of new taste.

Appearance: jet black, fine tan head with medium retention.

Aroma: rich flavor with dominating coffee and roastiness, dried fruits, hints of caramel.

Tasting notes: deep and profound bitterness of dark and special malts intervenes with hops bitterness, coffee notes, burnt sugar, treacle, raisins, dried plums.

Aftertaste: long lasting coffee and malts roastiness, warming alcohol.

Malts: Pale Malt, Wheat Malt, Special B, Melanoiden, Caraaroma, Caramunich, Carafa III, Roasted Barley, Chocolate

Hops: Columbus, Simcoe, Willamette
