- Connecting the intergovernmental processes with businesses, academia, education, the social sector, as well as, in a broader and general manner, with the civil society of both regions.
- **Promoting** the development of a joint and forward-looking global vision with shared strategies in both regions.
- Dynamising the bi-regional strategic partnership by encouraging and advocating for the formulation and implementation of policies and agendas.
- Circulating knowledge to raise mutual understanding and increase the visibility of both regions and the importance of the bi-regional partnership itself.

Activities with Economic and Business Partners (1/2)

We promote several initiatives in the economic and business field, with the underlying goal of promoting the development of bi-regional value chains and productivity:

- a) promotion of a bi-regional network and studies on competitive clusters (Polos);
- b) promotion of a bi-regional network and studies on corporate social responsibility;

- g) Coordinated with **ELANBiz and the Baltic States** to undertake a market study on e-government in Chile and Costa Rica (being presented today).
- h) Disseminate information and promote dialogue on bi-regional economic relationship. Held Reflection Forum on promoting competitiveness and productivity in the two regions in July in Madrid:

- Participate in **internship programme**, consider possible secondment programme or other opportunities for collaboration.






Digital Library
