With a satisfaction rate above 90%, 154 companies already involved in a concrete deal, 291 companies with an agreement on their way, the success of the initiative has been confirmed by all the parties involved.



This unique opportunity is in line with the strong, dynamic and continuously evolving EU-Australia relationship which, especially on Science and Technology (S&T) started over 24 years ago when Australia was the first country to sign an S&T agreement with the EU. Since then, collaboration has been continually growing and EU-Australia relationship are now taking a next step as Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull, the President of the European Council Donald Tusk and President of the European Commission Jean Claude Juncker agreed

to start the process towards the launch of negotiations for an ambitious Free Trade Agreement.
