### Natural honey

- Mexico was the 13<sup>rd</sup> world exporter of natural honey. Its exports represented 2.42% of world exports for this product, in 2020.
- In 2020, Mexico exported 22,618 tons of natural honey.
- **Mexico was the 1<sup>st</sup> source of natural honey imports from Germany**, 4<sup>th</sup> from Belgium, 6<sup>th</sup> from United States, 16<sup>th</sup> from Spain, and 18<sup>th</sup> from Poland.

- In 2018, Mexico exported 123,281 tons of coffee, whether or not roasted or decaffeinated; coffee husks and skins.
- **Mexico was the 8<sup>th</sup> source of coffee from United States**, 12<sup>st</sup> from Belgium, 14<sup>th</sup> from Spain, 15<sup>th</sup> from France, 17<sup>th</sup> from Italy, and 24<sup>th</sup> from Germany.
