Article 1. Territory and Products

The Principal appoints the Agent, who accepts, as his commercial agent, to promote the sale of the products manufactured by the Principal or defined in annex of this contract (hereinafter called "the Products") in the following territory:...... (Hereinafter called "the Territory").

Article 2. Functions of the Agent

- 2.1. The Agent agrees to use his best endeavours to promote the sale of the Products in the Territory in accordance with the Principal's reasonable instructions and shall protect the Principal's interests with the diligence of a responsible businessman.
- 2.2. The Agent shall not solicit orders from outside the Territory unless permitted to do so by the Principal.
- 2.3. Unless otherwise specifically agreed, the Agent has no authority to make contracts on behalf of, or in any way to bind the Principal towards third parties. He only solicits orders from customers for the Principal, who is free to accept or to reject them.
- 2.4. When negotiating with customers, the Agent shall offer Products strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract of sale which the Principal has communicated to him.
